At Plantas nativa, LLC, our mission is to promote the use of native plants. We network with many native plant growers to make their plant stock available to native plant enthusiasts. This species list includes most Washington native species that are commercially available. Delivery is usually available throughout the Puget Sound region.

Plant material can be available in many forms. "Bare root" seedlings are usually available during December thru April, with certain exceptions. Containerized stock is available year-round and may be in tubes (roughly 8" x 1.5"), 4" pots, 1- gallon, 2-gallon, 5-gallon, or larger.

Availability: Our inventory changes daily. Not all plants sizes and species are available at all times. This list is not intended as a comprehensive list of pacific northwest native plants, but rather species often commercially available. Please inquire for current availability.

Pricing: In general, plant prices are \$3 for 4 inch and tubes, \$6 for one gallon, \$12 for two gallon. Bare-root stock and various prices for larger plants. However, a few plants have special pricing, so please call for current prices.

Terms and Conditions: The balance is due in full at the time of pick up or before shipping. Shipping and/or delivery is available at cost and upon request. We do not have minimum orders for our stock on hand. For special orders we require a 50% deposit, and a 25% charge for canceled or returned orders.

Quality: We take care to provide quality, healthy plants, true to species. However, we do not guarantee plant survivability after leaving our care, and give no guarantee, expressed or implied, as to productiveness or life span. We will review plant claims if they are reported within 30 days, and the material returned with the original tags and receipt.
